✓ According to Human Resources Social Development Canada, an RESP can be opened without any money down. In such cases and where the parent/guardian qualifies for the Canada Learning Bond, the federal government will provide the bank with \$25 to offset the cost of opening an RESP.

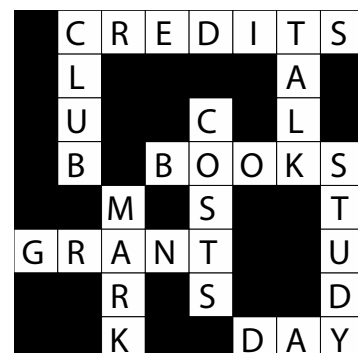

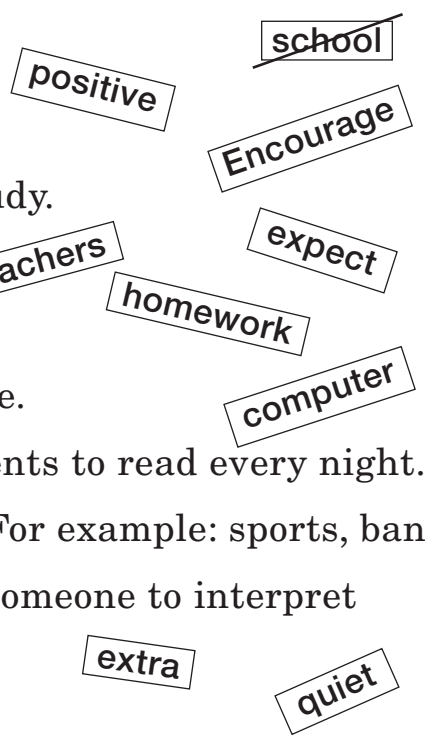
